The Bureau of Reclamation will host a grant writing workshop for Arizona. The workshop will discuss how to write successful proposals to receive Federal funding, with a focus on Reclamation's WaterSMART program, and an opportunity to ask questions on project ideas and proposals.

About WaterSMART: Adequate and safe water supplies are fundamental to the health, economy, and security of the country. Through WaterSMART, Reclamation works cooperatively with States, Tribes, and local entities as they plan for and implement actions to increase water supply through investments to modernize existing infrastructure.

Who should attend: State agencies, Indian tribes, irrigation districts, water districts, or other organizations with water or power delivery authority, non-profit organizations involved in water management activities, local watershed groups, and universities and research institutes.
