

**Joint Village Strategic Planning Meeting Notes**  
**Tuesday, May 25, 2021**  
**10 AM MST**  
**Zoom Videoconference and Telephone**

**1. Call to Order**

Brian Cole called the meeting to order at 10:08 AM MST.

Shingoitewa speculated that the Hopi Tribal Council may be meeting in-person as early as June. There was broad consensus that this was a good idea—that we should table the resolution request until a time certain. The group unanimously recommended that Philton Talahytewa request 9 AM on Tuesday, June 8 to make the presentation/request.
